Dear Families,

Welcome back to the start of term 2! We are looking forward to a busy and productive term, with heaps already booked in. This is a very short term (only nine weeks including this one) and there is a lot to get through from a school perspective – NAPLAN, school based assessments, report writing and parent teacher interviews – not to mention teaching and looking after all our wonderful children! I would like to extend a warm welcome to our new teachers for this term, Jane in 1/2 and Robyn in 4/5. I am very pleased that they have joined out Trentham community and look forward to working with them in the future.

I hope that you all managed to get some down time over Easter. You will have seen on the news that the COVID rules have changed again, and we are no longer mandated to wear masks at school which is a great relief for us all. We are still managing the occasional case in the community, so I would like to confirm that close contacts of positive cases are no longer required to isolate unless they have symptoms. We will continue to send home RAT tests as we receive them from the department to help with managing this.

It was lovely to see some of the children at the Trentham ANZAC day service on Monday. Our senior kids did an amazing job and I was very proud indeed of the way that they conducted themselves and took part in the ceremony. Well done all! Next Saturday, the 7th, we are very excited to have our school band performing at Spudfest. Please also consider helping out with the face-painting or the petting zoo – all of the money raised at these events comes to Trentham PS to support your children's education.
